

There are seven new entries in this year's Tomato Market. See below:



Pineapple: If you are looking for a beautiful, productive Beefsteak tomato, this is it. Pineapple is marbled yellow and red, both inside and out, and has a rich, fruity, sweet flavor. It is open-pollinated and will be ready to eat in 75-95 days.



Jetsetter: If you are looking for an alternative to Early Girl and want a huge producer for containers or cooler climates, this is your choice. Jetsetter has great flavor and produces tomatoes that are juicy on flattened 8-ounce globes. It is a disease resistant hybrid and matures in approximately 65 days.



Russian Big Roma: If you are looking for a paste tomato for your sauces and other cooked tomato recipes, Russian Big Roma is this year's entry. It produces lots of large, deep red, meaty fruits with exceptional flavor. It is a disease-resistant hybrid that matures in 85 days.



Black Beauty is a Beefsteak hybrid tomato that matures in approximately 85 days. The tomatoes appear solid blue-black on the skin. The taste is rich, smooth and savory with earthy tones. The tomatoes have a high antioxidant content and store well.



Blush Cherry is open-pollinated and matures in approximately 70 days. It is a bullet-shaped cherry that is large enough to slice, yet still small enough for snacking. It is a bright yellow tomato with red stripes. The flavor is complex, mellow and not too sweet. It works well in containers and cool climates.



Green Giant is a green heirloom Beefsteak tomato that is 12-18 ounces in size. It is ready to eat in approximately 85 days. It is a complex and delicious combination of sweet and spicy that is rich and well-balanced.



Japanese Black Trifele is a pear-shaped Heirloom tomato that matures in approximately 80 days. It has green-streaked shoulders that deepen to a mahogany color and finally to a darkened, nearly black base. This tomato does well in coast/cool climates. Its flavor is complex and rich. The plant is highly productive, and the fruit is very crack-resistant.
